Gel is provided at the front door for entry into school. 3) Tissues are available for the children to use. A separate lidded bin is provided for tissues which will be doubled bagged for disposal. Windows will be opened and hand gel made available. 4) Enhanced cleaning has been timetabled in to reduce risk, using screen spray and clean cloths each day. 5) The children in the SRB as in a bubble and do not mix with other children within our school.

Please note that forms received will be shared with Norfolk and Waveney Clinical Commissioning Group to reduce duplicate effort across health provider services.
