


What happens when you add an 's' to a word ending in 'y'? cry – cries spy – spies dry – dries Have a go at writing these and use a different colour for the suffix.</p>	<p>Grammar Nouns, adjectives, verbs and adverbs Use the worksheet and correctly colour in the words on the beetle.</p>	<p>Nurture - Mrs Riccobena's Activity!
