#### Intent:

Browick Road Primary and Nursery School aims to provide opportunities for pupils to become expressive Artists who are confident to explore and use a wide range of tools and materials. We ensure that pupils are equipped to successfully think, work and communicate like an artist. We aim to provide pupils with ample opportunities to develop their artistic skills. We want all our pupils to become creative thinkers and learners, exploring their ideas and recording their experiences. Progression through the school has been carefully constructed to ensure that pupils can revisit key disciplines throughout their Primary journey at increasing degrees of challenge and complexity.

### Implementation:

During their time at Browick Road, children develop their skills in all the artistic disciplines, including drawing, painting, printmaking, textiles, 3D and collage. These skills are developed by working individually as well as collaboratively with other pupils in a variety of contexts. Whilst exploring using different tools and materials, children learn about working safely and using protective measures. They develop the skills to be able to evaluate their work and the work of their peers, as well as other artists. Pupils' oracy and vocabulary skills will be developed to enable them to use artistic language meaningfully when talking about their work and the work of others.
