Our Teachers... are creative, engaging and adventurous, offering an excellent curriculum that challenges and inspires to ensure every child is **ACHIEVING**.

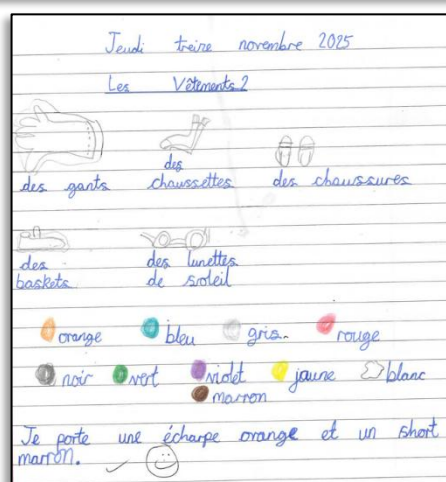

Intent:

At Browick Road Primary School, we believe in providing an engaging, stimulating, and challenging languages curriculum that nurtures curiosity and confidence. Our intention is to develop pupils' linguistic competence through rich speaking, listening, reading, and writing experiences, while also valuing languages as a powerful social and cultural learning opportunity. As members of a multilingual and multicultural world, our children learn to appreciate, understand, and respect the rich diversity of global cultures and languages that shape the world around them.

Implementation:

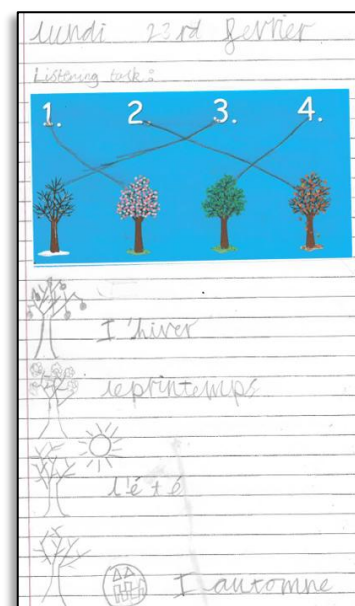
To enable children to focus on one language in depth and make strong, sustained progress, we have chosen to teach French throughout the school. Although languages become statutory in Key Stage Two, we believe early exposure is useful in helping children develop an understanding of other countries, cultures, and languages. Across the school, French is taught using the Language Angels scheme, ensuring consistency, progression, and high-quality resources.

In EYFS, children explore different cultures and begin to encounter new language through songs and playful experiences. In Key Stage 1, pupils enjoy early speaking and listening activities, with vocabulary linked to wider curriculum learning wherever possible.

In Key Stage 2, children progress through topic-based units that build systematically on prior knowledge. Teaching focuses on the three pillars of language learning: phonics, vocabulary, and grammar - giving pupils regular opportunities to practise and apply these foundations across speaking, listening, reading, and writing.

Enrichment:

We enrich language learning through vibrant cultural experiences, including the European Day of Languages, where the whole school explores greetings, traditions, and stories from across Europe. We also celebrate the many languages spoken by our pupils, and our country class names provide opportunities to encounter new and unique languages each year, strengthening curiosity and cultural understanding.
